ADC KRONE Awarded Major Contract for London Heathrow Airport

ADC KRONE's Enterprise Networking, Fibre and Copper Connectivity Solutions Selected by ntl for Network Infrastructure Terminal 5

ADC KRONE today announced it has been awarded a significant contract from British Airports Authority (BAA), through their major infrastructure provider ntl. The terms of the contract call for a range of ADC KRONE enterprise networking, copper and fibre connectivity solutions to be deployed at London Heathrow Airport, Terminal 5. When completed in 2011, Terminal 5 will have the capacity to handle 30 million passengers annually, taking London Heathrow's total number of passengers to around 90 million per year. This will make London Heathrow the world's busiest airport.

ADC KRONE's total networking solution will enable a variety of voice and data applications from supplying the data for passenger information displays, check-in desk computer systems, baggage handling security through to point-of-sale units at the terminal's planned extensive retail and hospitality outlets.
