MINNEAPOLIS, MN USA – March 11, 2008 — ADC (NASDAQ: ADCT; www.adc.com) today announced that Scania, one of the world's leading manufacturers of heavy trucks, buses and engines, is using the ADC InterReach® Unison in-building wireless solution to deliver high-quality mobile coverage at its main production facility in Sweden.
